



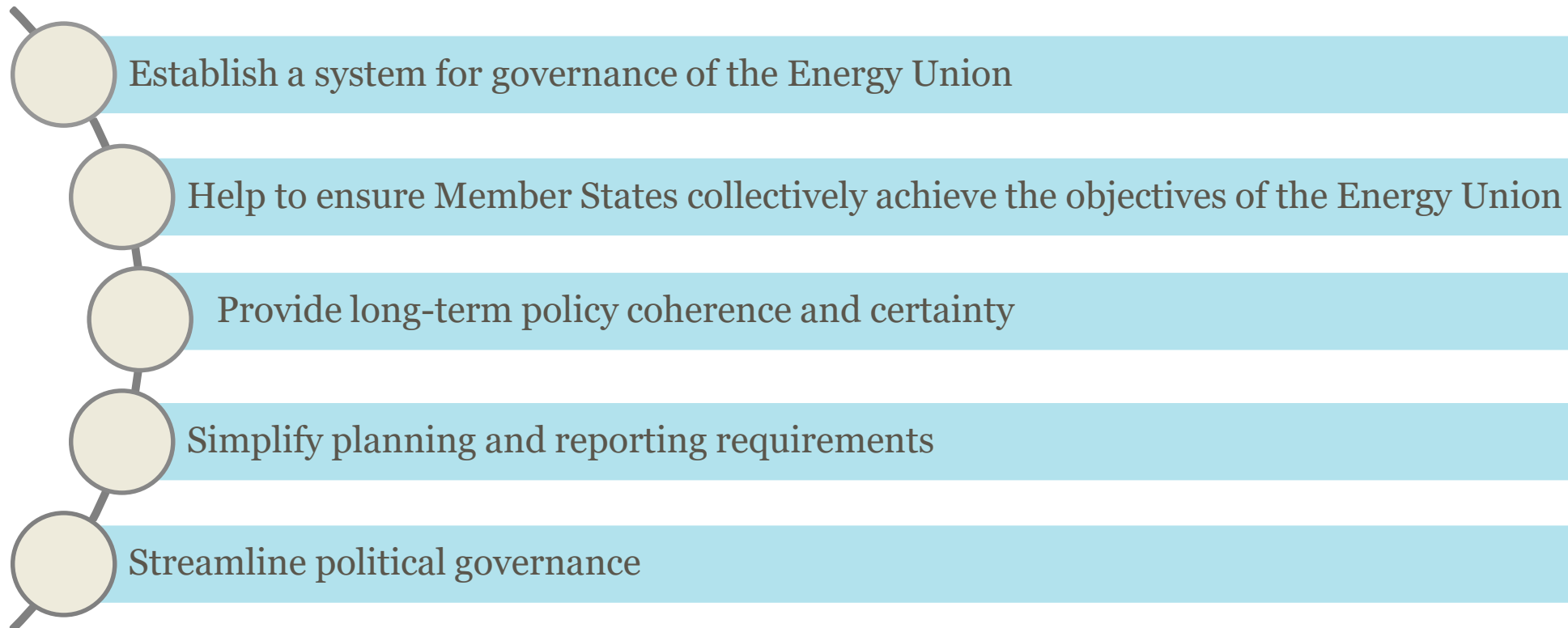
Clean Energy Package: Governance of the Energy Union

13 April 2018

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Background

- ***“Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Governance of the Energy Union”***



Article 1

“1. This Regulation establishes a Governance mechanism to:

- (a) implement strategies and measures designed to meet the objectives and targets of the Energy Union and the longer term objectives of the Paris Agreement, and for the first ten-year period from 2021 to 2030 in particular the Union's [] 2030 targets for energy and climate;*
- (b) ensure the timeliness, transparency, accuracy, consistency, comparability and completeness of reporting by the Union and its Member States to the UNFCCC and Paris Agreement secretariat.”*

(Draft, 16 March 2018)

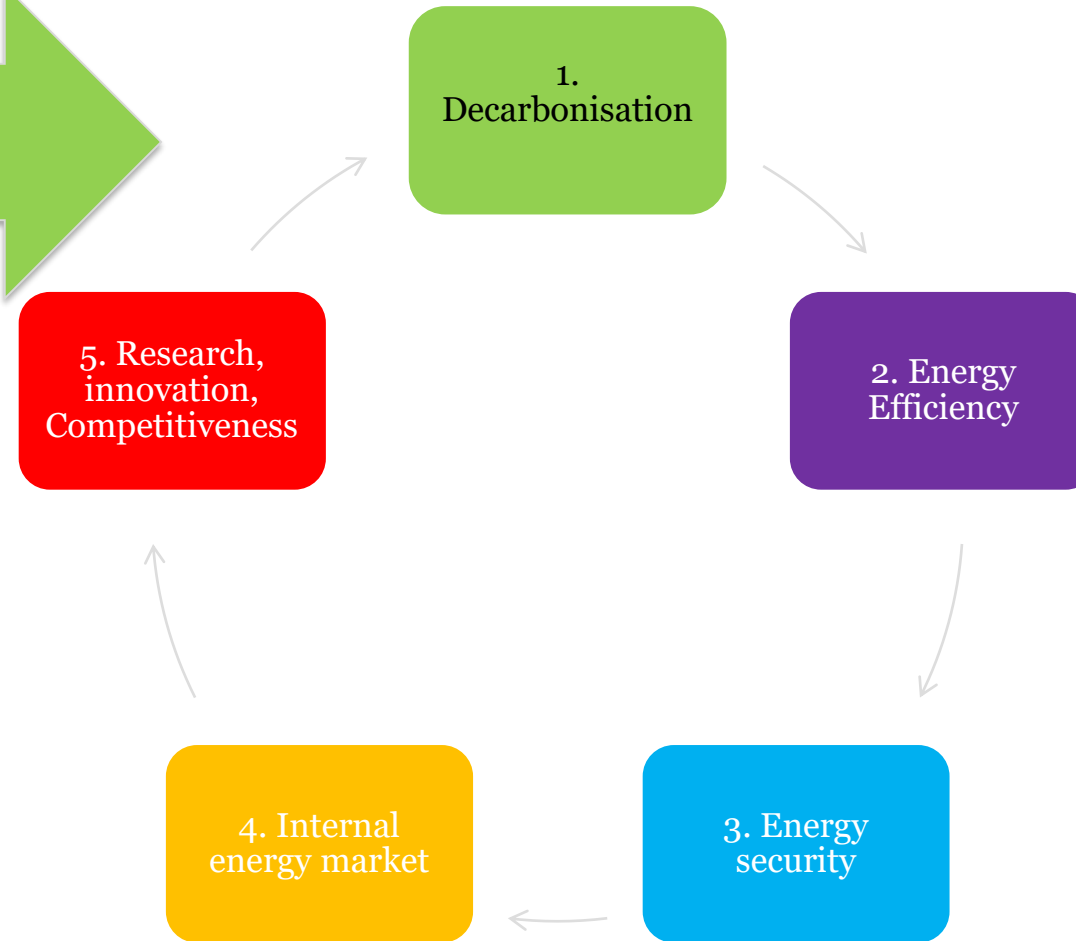

1. 10 Year National Energy and Climate Plans: Overview

Deadline: 31 December 2019

2. National Energy and Climate Plans: Reporting Obligations

- Progress reports – 15 March 2023, and every two years after that
- Chapter 4 of the Proposed Regulation sets out what needs to be covered in respect of each of the five dimensions of the Energy Union

3. National Energy and Climate Plans: Monitoring & Compliance

- Monitoring v Enforcement
- Issues
 - Inconsistencies
 - Insufficient ambition
 - Insufficient progress (at both individual Member State and overall EU level)



3. National Energy and Climate Plans: Monitoring & Compliance

- Article 27(4): additional measures to address any “emerging gap” in renewable energy objectives, such as:
 - a) adjusting the share of renewable energy in the heating and cooling sector set out in Article 23(1) [recast of Directive 2009/28/EC as proposed by COM(2016) 767];*
 - b) adjusting the share of renewable energy in the transport sector set out in Article 25(1) [recast of Directive 2009/28/EC as proposed by COM(2016) 767];*
 - c) making a financial contribution to a financing platform set up at Union level, contributing to renewable energy projects and managed directly or indirectly by the Commission;*
 - d) other measures to increase deployment of renewable energy.*

- 2020 objective
